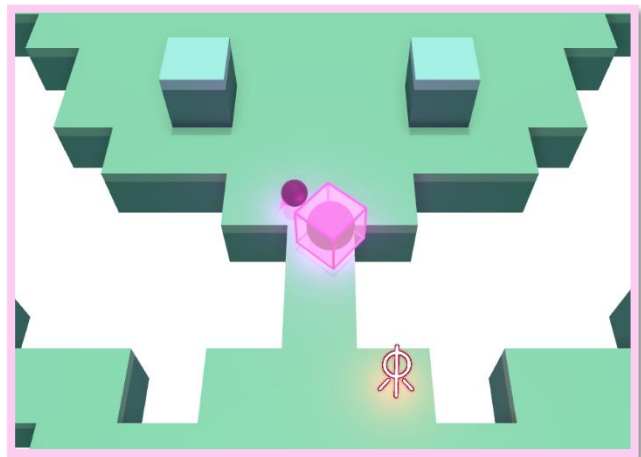
"Attila: Flagellum Day" is a **survival, PvE** videogame, where players step into the shoes of **Attila the Ball**, a powerful entity, born as an experiment about psychic powers, now fleeing from the laboratory where it has been created. Unleash Attila's psychic skills, survive the robotic guards, begin the Flagellum Day.

Core Gameplay

In "Attila: Flagellum Day", the player directly controls Attila, **rolling** its purple spheric body around the in-game map, caring to avoid various obstacles such as **pits, walls, and enemies**.

The core objective of the game is to **survive waves of enemies** that one after the other will come down on the player. To succeed in this task, the player will be able to draw on Attila's numerous **skills**, unleashed upon the collection of **runes** (collectable objects generated on the game map).

- **Runes** are the symbols by which the cosmos communicates with itself, and Attila can read them. After collecting three runes, the player will activate one of Attila's skills based on the obtained **sequence** of Runes.
- **Skills** range from survival resources, such as **cures** and **shields**, to attack tools: Attila can generate entire **planetary systems** orbiting around him, throw enemies away with his **psychic pulse**, and much more.

As the game progresses, punctuated by rounds and waves, enemies will become more numerous and powerful, a feature that aims, combined with the map and game design, to entice the player to pursue a **strategic** style of play.

Conclusion

"Attila: Flagellum Day" aims to satisfy players who crave an increasing level of **challenge**, while at the same time rewarding the player's **knowledge** of the game, who will have to rely on their **memory** to fully understand the link between runes and skills.
